Discussion of how to value the property began. Stuart suggested that we utilize the same process as before for the Kempe Home that burned in September of 2020.

Valuation of Monica Hampton a.k.a Monica Wood's property for abatement of a portion of the 2022 to 2023 taxes.

Replacement cost new less depreciation: \$153,500

Tax rate combined: X 1.6967%

Total taxes paid for home value: 2604.43

Per Diem tax rate: \$2,604.43/365= \$7.135 per diem

Days since fire to Fiscal year end: 156

Balance of the year from January 25th:January – 6 days

February – 28 days

March – 31 days

April – 30 days

May – 31 days

<u>June – 30 days</u>

Total days = 156

 $$7.135 \times 156 = 1113.13 requested abatement amount to be applied to the total tax year. Paid \$829.31 in November 2022 already paid. \$1113.13 - \$829.31 leaves a credit a credit of \$283.82 to be applied to the next tax year November 2023.

Linda Runnion moved to pass the calculation to value of the house and seconded by Beth and Tom Garbitelli at the same time.
