- 4. Town Plan Discussion Planning Commission hearing, Selectboard hearing
 - a. Jon Binhammer shared an update that the Selectboard has requested some changes to the Natural Resources section of the Town Plan. Jon Jickling suggested it may be related to Forest Blocks and Wildlife overlays and whether both are needed or if they can be combined into one overlay. The Commissioners agreed that there is specific rationale for having both overlays and that it may be worthy to reiterate that to the Selectboard. The plan includes harvest for the pine stand in the forest affected by pine needle cast infection to reduce further risk of mortality.

 - b. Susan Shea provided an overview of the flood resilience events hosted with the White River Partnership in June.
